SPOT & STAIN REMOVER: Safely removes fresh and old stains from carpets and soft furnishings and dries to a crystalline residue, which is simply vacuumed away. It contains no bleach and is particularly good at removing red wine, fruit juice, coffee and tea stains. It can also be used as a laundry pre-spotter.

HOW TO USE

MAGIC SPOT & STAIN REMOVER is used directly from the bottle as a ready to go solution and requires no dilution with water.

- It should be remembered that the quicker you attend to the spillage the better the chances that it will be removed effectively.
- Soak up as much spillage as possible with disposable paper.

- Spray and work the foam (using a nail brush in from outside of spill towards the centre. Leave to stand for 10 minutes and then wipe away the dirty foam.
- Repeat the process until the foam is clean. Leave to dry and then vacuum away the crystalline residue.

Caution: Test for colour fastness on a small inconspicuous area by leaving for 15 minutes.

SAFETY ADVICE

Not classified as hazardous, however we advise that normal cleaning safety practices are adopted. Wear protective gloves. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists get medical attention.
